CRIME SNAPSHOT

20/04/24 - Theft HB at Takeaway on Annan Road – a male was arrested and charged with the relevant offence.

20/04/24 –3 males arrested for fighting on Great King Street, Dumfries. Contrary to some social media excitement there was not a helicopter deployed to this incident.

21/04/24 – Attempted Murder involving a weapon, Glebe Street, Dumfries. A male was arrested and has been charged with this offence. The community council may be aware of this incident due to press and social media reporting.

21/04/24 – Serious assault in licensed premises. Enquiries continue with a view to reporting two individuals in relation to the incident.

23/04/24 – A male on motorbike no helmet but face covered at Burns Statue. If this male or like riders are seen please report to the Police as we are keen to identify this individual.

25/04/24 – a female was arrested for assault and robbery in Brewery Street, Dumfries within a domestic property.

28/04/24 – Police on patrol stopped vehicle and the driver ran off. It was established the vehicle was stolen following a housebreaking. The driver was apprehended and arrested for a number of offences.

ACQUISITIVE CRIME

2 males from West Bromwich arrested and found with stolen property worth £15k after a theft by shoplifting from a town centre store

2 females and a male arrested and found with stolen property worth £5k following theft by shoplifting from a supermarket.
